

Posthumous Tun award for ex-Petronas chief

KUALA LUMPUR: Puan Sri Noor Ainee Che Teh received from Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin the Seri Setia Mahkota Malaysia (SSM), carrying the title "Tun", awarded posthumously to her husband, former Putrajaya Corporation president and former Petronas president Tan Sri Azizan Zainul Abidin, at an investiture at Istana Negara yesterday.

Azizan, who was a respected corporate leader in the public and private sectors, died on July 14, 2004 at the age of 68.

He was one of the 1,626 people bestowed awards and medals in conjunction with the birthday of the king.

Yesterday, two people received the Panglima Mangku Negara (PMN) which carries the title "Tan Sri". They were Chief of Defence Forces Gen Tan Sri Azizan Ariffin and Public Service Department Director-General Tan Sri Ismail Adam.
